

Disability Claim Advocacy

VFW Service Officers assists and advocates for veterans in accessing disability benefits, while also educating veterans and their family members about the resources they earned during their service to this Nation.

Michigan's VFW runs a children's camp near Newaygo, Michigan every summer for 7-12 year olds. We sponsor Scout Troops, and run an annual local, state and national level literary and oratorical scholarship program for 9-12 graders.
